INFORMATION ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The Special Talent Scholarship is a non-need based scholarship of \$4,000 based on \$1,000 per year for a maximum of four years. In order to maintain the scholarship, the student must

1. Carry at least 12 credit hours each semester.
2. Maintain an overall grade point average of 2.5 on a four point system at Central Michigan University.
3. Satisfactorily prepare for and participate in a minimum of three tournaments per semester.
4. Make an earnest effort to implement the suggestions of the coaching staff concerning preparation for competition.
5. Make an earnest effort to attend appropriate tournaments designated by the coaching staff.
6. Assist with events and tournaments sponsored by the Central Michigan University Forensics program.
